SOCIAL SECURITY

Find out if you and/or your children are entitled to benefits.

SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION 1-800-772-1213

Open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

- The SSA provides a monthly stipend for eligible individuals. Contact Social Security after the Petirah to determine if you are eligible for benefits and to apply.
- Survivor Benefits are available to surviving spouses (beginning at age 60) and minor children who are orphaned of either parent (up to age 18, or longer if child is enrolled in school) if the deceased spouse/ parent earned a paycheck.
- You will only begin receiving benefits once you apply; no retroactive benefits will be paid.
